BEYOND THE CITY

HARPERS FERRY, WEST VIRGINIA

This mountain-framed hamlet, rich in Civil War lore and natural beauty, beckons history buffs and outdoor explorers alike. Wander the preserved district with its old-world architecture and restored storefronts, then head into the hills for sweeping views from Maryland Heights. The confluence of rivers adds a touch of magic, perfect for kayaking or quiet reflection. Refuel with hearty American fare at a cozy tavern or sip a locally brewed IPA as the sun sets behind the ridge. It's a storybook escape just waiting to be explored.

ATLANTIC CITY, NEW JERSEY

Escape the city and dive one hour and fifteen minutes into Atlantic City's one-of-a-kind blend of beach serenity and boardwalk excitement. Here, you can dig your toes into golden sands by morning and then chase thrills in buzzing casinos or arcades by afternoon. Amble along the famed wooden boardwalk lined with saltwater taffy, street performers, and souvenir shops. For food lovers, the local seafood scene is unbeatable, from casual bayside crab shacks to upscale surf-and-turf spots. When the sun goes down, Atlantic City comes alive with live music, stylish lounges, and beachfront bars that carry the beat late into the night. It's a classic beach getaway with a vibrant twist.

WASHINGTON, DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

Make your way just over one hour south to a city where every monument tells a story and every block hums with cultural energy. Washington, D.C., offers a day filled with discovery, from the grandeur of the Lincoln and Jefferson Memorials to the rich exhibits of the Smithsonian museums. Whether you're walking under cherry blossom trees or cruising past landmarks on a scenic riverboat ride, D.C. surrounds you with inspiration. Tuck into global flavors at bistros in Dupont Circle or explore soulful jazz venues echoing the city's musical roots. Finish your visit with a signature cocktail atop a high-rise bar, gazing out over the capital's lights. It's history with a heartbeat.

PENNSYLVANIA WINE COUNTRY

Let the rolling hills and rustic elegance of Pennsylvania's wine regions whisk you away to a slower pace.
