For lively summer evenings, Mizner Park Amphitheater hosts "Summer in the City," a vibrant outdoor concert series featuring live music and community gatherings under the stars.

When twilight settles over Boca Raton, a diverse culinary and nightlife scene awakens, catering to every palate and preference. Downtown offers a myriad of tempting options, from casual eateries to refined dining experiences. Loch Bar, situated in Mizner Park, combines the charm of an upscale seafood tavern with a lively ambiance, offering freshly caught seafood, an expansive raw bar, and handcrafted cocktails accompanied by live entertainment. For those seeking chic sophistication, Boca Luna Luxe Lounge provides panoramic city views, creative mixology, and rooftop dancing to vibrant DJ beats. Visitors seeking laid-back fun can visit local favorites like Funky Biscuit, an intimate venue renowned for its exceptional blues and rock performances, or the Biergarten at Royal Palm Place, where craft beers flow freely amidst cheerful crowds and a communal atmosphere. BEYOND THE CITY

MIAMI, FLORIDA

Just an hour south, Miami dazzles with its vibrant city life, golden beaches, and diverse culture. Wander the lively streets of South Beach, exploring pastel-hued Art Deco architecture, or discover artistic masterpieces in Wynwood's dynamic mural district. Immerse yourself in the Cuban heritage of Little Havana, savor authentic cuisine at Versailles, or enjoy iconic seafood at Joe's Stone Crab. PALM BEACH & WEST PALM BEACH, FLORIDA

EVERGLADES NATIONAL PARK, FLORIDA

ISLAMORADA, FLORIDA KEYS

Enjoy waterside dining at Lorelei Cabana Bar or Hungry Tarpon at Robbie's, then unwind to live music at local tiki bars, sipping tropical cocktails under star-filled skies—truly capturing the relaxed spirit of the Keys.

NAPLES, FLORIDA

Crossing Florida's peninsula westward brings you to Naples, renowned for its tranquil Gulf beaches and upscale ambiance. JUPITER & HOBE SOUND, FLORIDA

Ascend Jupiter Inlet Lighthouse for breathtaking ocean vistas, or marvel at Blowing Rocks Preserve's dramatic wave-sculpted shoreline. Enjoy kayaking through tranquil Riverbend Park or visit Loggerhead Marinelifelife Center to encounter rescued sea turtles up close. Delight in fresh seafood dining amid tropical greenery at Guanabanas or unwind at the Square Grouper Tiki Bar, known for its casual atmosphere and scenic sunsets—a perfect conclusion to this easygoing coastal escape.
