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Day 1: Downtown Sports, BBQ, and Live Music

In the afternoon, continue your sports journey with a guided tour of Minute Maid Park, the home stadium of the Astros, visiting exclusive areas like the press box and dugouts while learning about the ballpark's unique design. Afterward, unwind by strolling through the vibrant Discovery Green Park, admiring public art installations, or relaxing at historic Market Square Park. In the evening, experience Houston's rich culinary tradition at The Original Ninfa's on Navigation, the birthplace of the Tex-Mex fajita, where sizzling platters and homemade tortillas are a must.

Finish your first day with live entertainment at The Continental Club in Midtown, an iconic music venue featuring blues, rock, or country bands. Enjoy the club's lively atmosphere, vintage vibe, and excellent local performances, capturing Houston's eclectic nightlife at its best.

Day 2 – Museum District, History & Evening Entertainment

On day two, begin at the Houston Arboretum & Nature Center, where you can enjoy serene wooded trails, wildlife, and ponds just minutes from the bustling city. Afterward, delve into local history at the Buffalo Soldiers National Museum, which is dedicated to the contributions of African American soldiers, and view personal artifacts and powerful exhibits. Continue your historical exploration at the Holocaust Museum Houston, a deeply impactful venue dedicated to remembrance and human rights education through compelling exhibits and personal testimonies. This evening, head to dinner at Gatlin's BBQ, where smoky brisket and Southern sides, such as collard greens and dirty rice, offer authentic Texas flavors.

Wrap up your evening at White Oak Music Hall, a vibrant indoor/outdoor venue hosting live performances across diverse musical genres, ranging from indie rock to country. Relax with drinks in hand, mingle with locals, and soak in the dynamic energy of Houston's nightlife.

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Day 3 – NASA Space Exploration & Final Farewell

On your final day, venture southeast to explore the world-renowned Space Center Houston, NASA's visitor complex. Take the popular NASA Tram Tour to visit Historic Mission Control, Rocket Park featuring the monumental Saturn V rocket, and Independence Plaza, housing the shuttle atop a Boeing 747. Immerse yourself in interactive exhibits, touch a lunar rock, and enjoy lunch onsite to maximize your NASA experience.

Returning to central Houston, spend a leisurely late afternoon strolling through serene Hermann Park, where you can enjoy its beautiful gardens, peaceful lakes, and relaxing atmosphere. Alternatively, explore the boutique shopping and cafés in Rice Village.

Celebrate your last night with a memorable dinner at Josephine's, which describes themselves as "A little bit classy and a little bit trashy." And serve some of the best Gulf Coast seafood in town. After dinner, unwind at nearby Axelrad Beer Garden or take in one of Houston's rooftop lounges, enjoying casual drinks, live music, and a relaxing atmosphere.

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
