Return to Kansas City for an afternoon stroll through the scenic Country Club Plaza, known for its Spanish-inspired architecture, fountains, and boutique shopping. Visit Loose Park for a peaceful walk in its historic rose garden or explore outdoor art at the nearby Nelson-Atkins Museum. In the evening, cheer on the Kansas City Royals at Kauffman Stadium, renowned for its iconic fountains, vibrant atmosphere, and delicious ballpark barbecue offerings.

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Day 3: Outlaws, Pony Express, and Farewell BBQ

Head north for a day trip to St. Joseph, Missouri, diving into the Wild West at the Pony Express Museum, where interactive exhibits vividly narrate the thrilling tale of America's early mail riders. Nearby, the Jesse James Home Museum and Patee House Museum offer fascinating insights into the legendary outlaw's life and local frontier history. Afterward, stroll through St. Joseph's charming historic downtown, stopping for lunch at Barbosa's Castillo.

Back in Kansas City, briefly explore Westport for unique souvenirs or admire Union Station's grand architecture. For an unforgettable dinner this evening, visit Joe's Kansas City Bar-B-Que, a world-renowned spot serving exceptional barbecue out of a gas station. Don't miss their famous Z-Man sandwich, featuring tender brisket topped with onion rings.

Wrap up your visit with a leisurely drive through downtown's vibrant Power & Light District and experience the lively nightlife vibe.
