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Day 1: Miami Essentials – South Beach, Art Deco & Little Havana

For dinner, choose from seafood restaurants on Ocean Drive or lively eateries on Española Way, followed by experiencing Miami's nightlife. Enjoy salsa dancing at Ball & Chain in Little Havana, energetic live music at Mango's Tropical Café, or cocktails at upscale rooftop lounges like Sugar in Brickell, ending your evening with spectacular city views.

In the evening, explore the vibrant Wynwood Arts District, famous for street murals and creative galleries. Wander through Wynwood Walls, snapping photos of captivating outdoor art. Enjoy dinner at trendy eateries like KYU or Coyo Taco, then experience Wynwood's lively nightlife scene, featuring eclectic bars like Gramps, craft breweries, and live music venues.

Day 3: Luxury, Relaxation & Sunset Views

Lunch casually at Boater's Grill, enjoying fresh seafood and marina vistas.

In the afternoon, visit elegant Coral Gables, strolling Mediterranean-style streets lined with boutiques along Miracle Mile. Explore historic sites like the Venetian Pool, a picturesque 1920s swimming area surrounded by lush gardens and waterfalls, or wander through the tropical beauty of Fairchild Botanic Garden. For a more cultural twist, admire the grandeur of the historic Biltmore Hotel, reflecting Coral Gables' luxurious past.

End your Miami adventure with an evening in sophisticated Brickell. Enjoy upscale shopping at Brickell City Centre, then indulge in dinner at renowned restaurants such as Zuma or La Mar, savoring fine international cuisines. Complete your trip with spectacular sunset views and cocktails from rooftop lounges like Sugar or Area 31, or take a serene evening stroll along the scenic Miami Riverwalk, absorbing the glittering lights and vibrant energy of Miami's skyline.
